Men's Indoor Cricket

"The Centre" General Indoor Cricket Rules

- Each team will consist of eight (8) players per side with a minimum of four (4) players required on court per side to start the game.
- The game fee per team is **\$60.00** and must be paid at "The Centre" desk **prior to each game**. The scoresheet will be issued once both teams have paid their fees.
- As this is an adult competition, all "juniors" play in the knowledge that they accept the risks and liability that may be involved in such a competition.
- No more than four (4) players are allowed in the front or back half of the court until after the ball has been delivered.
- The batting team must provide a square leg umpire.
- The floor level skirting boards are considered to be part of the wall, although a player cannot be "caught out" off the skirting board.
- The roof net is considered to be neutral and play continues as per normal. ie. A ball may be caught out off the roof net but if not caught, then the normal runs for that stroke will be scored.
- All forms of dismissal will incur a penalty of minus four (-4) runs.
- Both batsmen **must** change ends at the conclusion of each over.
- **A "no ball" will be called:**
 - if the bowler begins his run up (or at any stage during his run up) with one or both feet wholly behind the designated start line.
 - if **any part** of the bowlers foot **makes contact** with the front bowling crease line during the delivery stride.
 - if the ball, once bowled, makes contact with the wooden floor prior to hitting the synthetic pitch.
 - if the ball, once bowled, reaches shoulder height or above of the batsmen in his normal batting stance position (if the batsmen moves forward more than one pace from his normal batting stance he will forego the right to a "no-ball").
 - if a team has more than four (4) players in either half of the court prior to the ball being delivered.
- A "wide" will be called if the ball passes the batsmen outside the designated "legside/offside" lines or at the umpire's discretion.
- All bats to be used in this competition will be supplied by the Rec Centre and **private bats are not permitted**.
- All other non- specified rules are as per the Australian Indoor Cricket Federation official rules of Indoor Cricket
